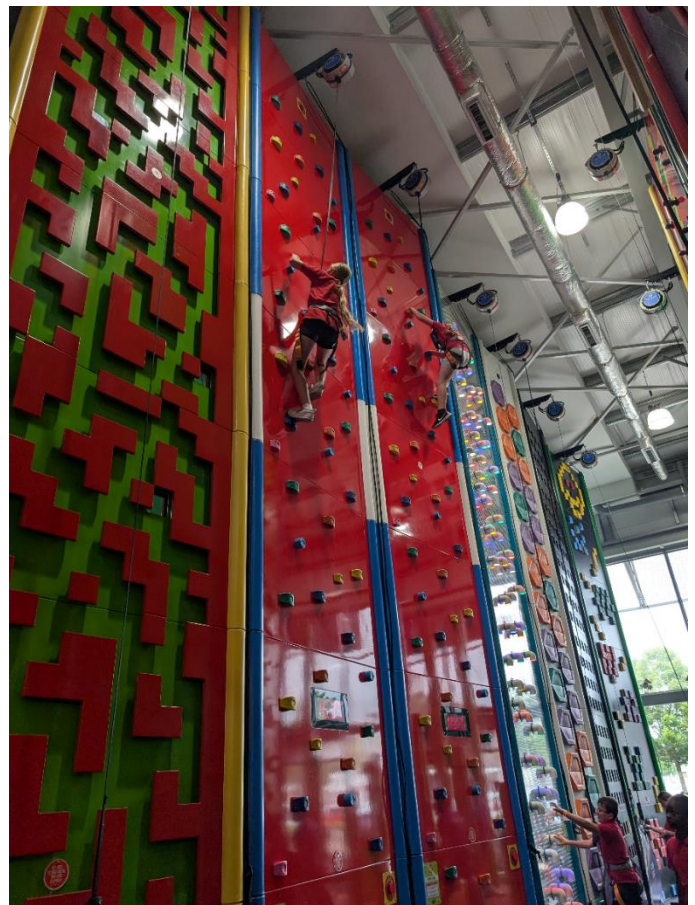
Thank you for the support of donating a £1 to allow the children to participate in the Match, it was a great event and we will look at organising another one in September

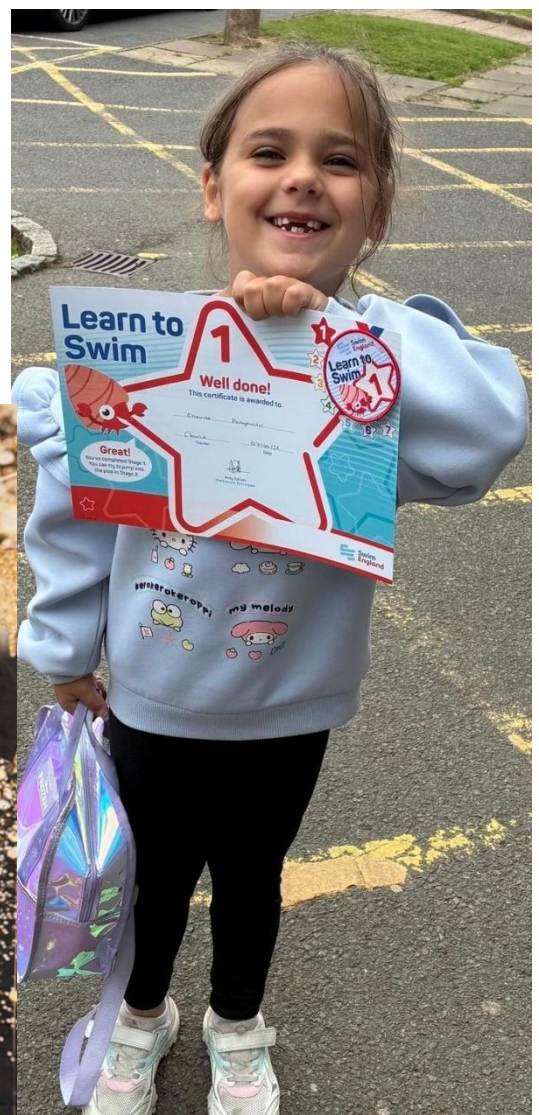
Phoenix class
